OUR EVENTS

Home Fun for Health Fair Business Appreciation Day Camden History Walking Tour Bingo Farmers Market Black Walnut Festival Haunted Camden Tours Holly Jolly Christmas

- We organized and held our inaugural **HOMERUN FOR HEALTH FAIR** in the spring of 2022 with representatives and practitioners from 31 health and social service organizations and the Mercy Health Mammogram van participating. Health information, screenings, testing, vaccines, were provided at no cost or covered by insurance. We also hosted a **HISTORIC CAMDEN WALKING TOUR** during the event.
- Our 3rd annual **BUSINESS APPRECIATION DAY**, which highlights and promotes our Camden businesses, drew a huge turnout again. With 27 businesses participating and offering deals, specials and door prizes, it was quite an event.
- We also with the LCNB's **KIDS OUTDOOR BUSINESS FAIR** for young entrepreneurs during the Business Appreciation Day and had 14 kids set up to sell their homemade artwork, goods, produce and items. Most all of the young entrepreneurs sold out of goods!
- Our annual BLACK WALNUT FESTIVAL attracts approximately 16,0000 visitors to Camden over the two-day weekend in October. Camden Comeback took over the management of the 30+ year-old Festival in 2021. In 2022, we increased the number of vendor and food truck spaces and added a Kid Zone and additional live entertainment. Our goal for the Black Walnut Festival is to be one of the best (or one of the best!) festivals of its size in the state. At the event we also offered our popular HAUNTED CAMDEN WAGON TOUR on Friday and Saturday of the Festival
- Started in 2022, our **SUMMER FARMERS MARKET** is held every Thursday June-September with many produce and product vendors sell their wares and goods in a parking area near downtown Camden. It's one of the largest weekly Farmers Markets in Preble County.
- We started hosting twice-monthly (typically) BINGO events in late 2021 as a way to raise money not only for Camden Comeback but also to assist location organizations and community improvement efforts. In 2022, Camden Comeback donated more than \$5,000 to other Camden and Preble Shawnee non-profit organizations.
- In December, we hosted our first HOLLY JOLLY CHRISTMAS event providing toys and books to children and others in the community, complete with Santa and the Grinch.

In partnership with the American Legion, we purchased two benches for the Tylersville Community Park splash zone and picnic areas in memory of two local students.
